Fraport Pioneers Specialization Course for Chief of Airport Fire Service

Fraport Brasil - Fortaleza to earn certification to teach courses to airport firefighters across the country.

Fraport Brasil - Fortaleza held the first Specialization Course for Chief of Airport Fire Service (CBA-CE) from August 31 and September 2 at the Fortaleza Airport.

With 22 class hours, the course included theoretical and practical lessons, group exercises, and assessments. Representatives of the National Civil Aviation Agency (Anac) participated in the course to audit the program's content and activities.

The course was made possible thanks to the Organization for Specialized Education for the Prevention, Rescue and Fire Fighting Service in Civil Airports (OE-SESCINC). Fifteen military firefighters of the 6th Company of the 1st Military Fire Battalion and one rescue and fire fighting supervisor of the Porto Alegre airport, in Rio Grande do Sul, were certified.

Among the objectives of this initiative is the development of airport firefighters' leadership skills and tasks in aeronautical and non-aeronautical emergencies at airports.

Fraport Brasil - Fortaleza is a pioneer in the provision of this specialized training program among airports managed by private companies in Brazil and can now serve the demand for this type of professional training.
