Fortaleza Airport installs automated boarding pass scanning system

The technology aims to speed up access to the boarding area

Access to the boarding area is now more convenient for both national and international passengers with the new automated boarding pass scanning system that uses the BCBP standard (Bar Coded Boarding Pass).

Eight machines were installed at the gateway to the domestic security screening area and six at the international one. As passengers place their printed or digital boarding passes on the device, it allows access to the inspection area.

The BCBP system adds agility by significantly improving passenger flow and avoiding lines. The new equipment reinforces Fraport Brasil - Fortaleza's commitment to provide passengers with a modern airport with international standards in security, operation and service.

Recent deliveries:

In late October, a small portion of the expanded boarding area was opened. Initially the three boarding bridges located in this area will be used for remote boarding. April 2020 is the deadline for the completion of the works.

Also in October, two new baggage carousels were delivered, completing the baggage claim area, which already had three new carousels.
